



Application Requirements

Application packages should include the following items submitted electronically at <u>one time</u> (not separately) to Q4C@brevardzoo.org:

- 1) Completed Brevard Zoo Conservation Fund (BZCF) application. Application form below;
- 2) Three photos (files 2 MB or larger) that best represent the project's work and accomplishments. Please attach photos to application email, or if images are too large to send by email please send link to photo sharing website for download. Also, please include captions and photo credits for each photo provided.

Additional documentation and supporting materials are optional.

Conditions of Acceptance

- 1. Brevard Zoo must receive a <u>final report within one year</u> of the project's receipt of the Brevard Zoo Conservation Fund payment. See "Final Report Guidelines" below.
- 2. Proceeds raised through Quarters for Conservation will be mailed to projects within the United States; International projects will have proceeds wired.
- 3. Brevard Zoo Conservation Fund will be acknowledged as a project sponsor in the following way:
 - In printed materials produced as a result of funding provided by Brevard Zoo Conservation Fund.
 - During formal talks given by the PI and in published papers authored by the PI as a result of funding provided by Brevard Zoo Conservation Fund.
 - On project's website.
- 4. Copies of applicable promotion/publications produced as a result of funding provided by Brevard Zoo Conservation Fund will be provided to Brevard Zoo.

I acknowledge that I have prior permission from photographers and subjects for all pictures provided to Brevard Zoo. Brevard Zoo may use these photos in social media, newsletters, and any other forms of marketing and updates relating to its conservation programs such as Quarters for Conservation.

Final Report Guidelines

Your final report will be shared with Brevard Zoo guests that fund the Quarters for Conservation program, and your project. This is your opportunity to speak directly to the guests, thank them for their support, and explain how they can participate in conservation in the future. The information and pictures you provide will be posted on the Brevard Zoo website, in the Zoo itself, and in member newsletters. Have fun with it!

Please include the following in the final report:

- 1. Specific description of how Brevard Zoo Conservation Fund money was spent,
- 2. Description of how Brevard Zoo Conservation Fund money benefited the project.
- 3. Major accomplishments of the project during the time period support was given by Brevard Zoo Conservation Fund.
- 4. Future goals for the project and how Brevard Zoo guests can help,
- 5. A minimum of three photos with captions, photo credits, and photo release waivers (if needed).

Only electronic formats of final reports will be accepted. The final report should be a maximum of two pages; Attachment of pictures and supporting documentation do not count against the page limit.
