Science Sundays Returning to Brevard Zoo

MELBOURNE, Fla., June 9, 2025 — Science Sundays will return to Brevard Zoo this summer with more fun educational entertainment designed to inspire curiosity and foster a love of science among guests of all ages.

This event will be held from 10 a.m.-3 p.m. on Sundays in July and August, offering guests the chance to beat the heat in the Zoo's air-conditioned event space: Nyami Nyami River Lodge. This event is free with Zoo admission.

Each Science Sunday program will feature a special topic hosted by a different Zoo team, giving guests the opportunity to learn from these experts. Guests will be able to enjoy behind-the-scenes looks at our Sea Turtle Healing Center or Zoo culinary team, learn the anatomy of a manatee from the Zoo's Conservation team, discover the animal science guiding zookeepers' work, and more. Interactive activities will bring the science behind these topics to life.

In addition, a special animal encounter will take place at the event at noon each Sunday.
